YOUR JOURNEY

Day 1 — GUWAHATI – POBITORA WILDLIFE SANCTUARY – UMIAM LAKE

Distance: 130 km | Drive: 4–5 Hours Upon arrival at Guwahati Airport, meet our representative and proceed to Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary for an exciting Jeep Safari (optional), renowned for its population of the Indian One-Horned Rhinoceros. Later, drive towards the picturesque Umiyam Lake and spend the evening enjoying the serene lakeside atmosphere. Places Covered: Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary Jeep Safari (Optional) Sunset View Point Overnight Stay: Umiyam Lake

Day 2 — UMIAM – KONGTHONG – MAWPHLANG

Distance: 110 km | Drive: 4 Hours After breakfast, drive to Kongthong, famously known as the "Whistling Village," where each resident has a unique whistled tune instead of a spoken name. Continue to Mawphlang to explore the Sacred Forest with a local guide and visit the Khasi Heritage Village. Places Covered: Kongthong Whistling Village | Mawphlang Sacred Forest | Khasi Heritage Village Overnight Stay: Mawphlang

Day 3 — MAWPHLANG – MAWLYNGBNA – SOHRA (CHERRAPUNJEE)

Distance: 95 km | Drive: 4 Hours Visit the adventure village of Mawlyngbna, known for its fossil park, natural balancing rock, river canyon, crystal-clear streams, kayaking, and short nature walks. Continue to Sohra (Cherrapunjee) in the evening. Places Covered: Mawlyngbna Fossil Park | Split Rock | River Canyon | Natural Swimming Pools Overnight Stay: Cherrapunjee

Day 4 — SOHRA EXPLORATION

Spend the day exploring the hidden natural wonders of Sohra. Places Covered: Wei Sawdong Waterfall | Dainthlen Falls | Garden of Caves | Arwah Cave | Wakhaba Falls | Nohkalikai Falls Overnight Stay: Cherrapunjee

Day 5 — NONGRIAT TREK OR PYNURSLA EXCURSION

Choose the experience that best suits your travel style. Option A (Adventure): Trek to the Double Decker Living Root Bridge | Rainbow Falls (Optional) Option B (Leisure): Pynursla | Mawkyrnnot Living Root Bridge | Hidden viewpoints overlooking Bangladesh Overnight Stay: Cherrapunjee

Day 6 — SOHRA – SHNONGPDENG – JOWAI

Distance: 125 km | Drive: 4–5 Hours After breakfast, drive to Shnongpdeng and enjoy the crystal-clear Umngot River with optional boating or kayaking. Continue to Jowai and visit the beautiful Krang Suri Waterfall before checking into your hotel. Places Covered: Shnongpdeng | Umngot River | Krang Suri Waterfall | Thadlaskein Lake (subject to time) Overnight Stay: Jowai

Day 7 — JOWAI – LUMSHNONG – GUWAHATI

Distance: 180 km | Drive: 5–6 Hours After breakfast, visit the scenic village of Lumshnong, known for its limestone cliffs and beautiful countryside. Later, drive back to Guwahati Airport for your onward journey. Places Covered: Lumshnong Viewpoints | Scenic Jaintia Hills Drive Tour Ends with Wonderful Memories!

TRAVEL TIPS

Carry a waterproof jacket, umbrella, quick-drying clothes, and good trekking shoes, as weather can change quickly, especially during the monsoon. Keep a basic medical kit, personal medicines, insect repellent, and sunscreen with you at all times. Mobile connectivity is good in Shillong and major towns but can be limited in remote villages and offbeat locations. Pre-book accommodation and transport during peak season (October–April) to avoid last-minute hassles. Wear comfortable walking shoes, as many attractions involve short hikes, village walks, and uneven terrain. Respect local Khasi, Jaintia, and Garo traditions, customs, and sacred sites. Always seek permission before photographing local people.Avoid littering and help preserve Meghalaya's pristine environment. Follow responsible tourism practices. During the monsoon season, trekking trails can become slippery. Follow local safety guidelines and consider hiring local guides for remote hikes. Carry sufficient cash when visiting remote areas, as ATMs and digital payment facilities may not always be available. Keep a government-issued photo ID handy for hotel check-ins and travel formalities. Tourist accommodations may require guest registration.Best Time to Visit: October to April for pleasant weather and sightseeing; July to September for lush greenery, misty landscapes, and spectacular waterfalls.Ideal For: Nature Lovers Adventure Seekers Photographers Hikers Cultural Explorers.
